Dear Parents/Guardians:

Re: Influenza Vaccine

The New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) requires all children, ages 6 months to 59 months, attending a child-care center or preschool facility to receive a seasonal Influenza Vaccine. Preschool aged students are vulnerable to flu related complications, the major one being Pneumonia.

It is recommended that you schedule an appointment early with your child's Pediatrician, the Newark Health Department, or local health center.

The following are a list of health care facilities in the community:

It may be ideal to schedule an appointment during the days off in November so that he/she can receive the required vaccine. Once verification is obtained please bring this information to the school. Students who have not been vaccinated by the <u>deadline</u>, <u>December 23</u>, <u>2020</u>, will not be permitted to return to school until proof of having received the Influenza Vaccine is submitted.

Medical exemptions from vaccines must be submitted in writing by your Health Care Provider with a medical reason. Religious exemptions from vaccines must be written and signed by a parent/guardian.
