Re: Exclusion notice for students who have **not** received and submitted a flu vaccine record

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 8:57-4.19 Children six months through 59 months of age attending any licensed child-care center or preschool facility on or after September 1, 2008 shall annually receive at least one dose of influenza vaccine between September 1 and December 31 of each year.

This serves as an exclusion notice for all students who have not yet received the influenza (flu) vaccine. The deadline to receive the influenza (flu) vaccine was December 31st, 2020.

The state guidelines provide for students that are not vaccinated to be excluded from school until after the end of the flu season which is defined as March 31st. Per the New Jersey Department of Health, "***The State Health Department's goal is not to exclude anyone, but if the child does not receive the vaccine by December 31, 2020, he/she will be asked to leave school***". Despite your child receiving virtual learning service, it is still considered that your child is in attendance.

Effective Monday, January 19, 2021, if your child has **not** been vaccinated he/she will be unable to log in to virtual classes and must return devices facilitated for virtual learning until they have received at least one dose of flu vaccine. Please make an appointment with your physician or local health department as soon as possible.
